### **EXCHANGE**

We have partnered with over 50 exchange providers from around the world. If you are enrolled at one of our partner institutions, you can apply for exchange. Exchange students pay their tuition fees to their home institution while they study at UC. You need to be nominated by your home institution before you can apply for exchange at University of Canberra. Head to our partners webpage to see if your home institution is one of our exchange partners.

### **STUDY ABROAD**

If your home institution doesn't have an agreement with UC, you can apply to enrol in our fee-paying Study Abroad program. Students completing Study Abroad can expect to pay a tuition cost of \$10,300 AUD per semester for 12 credits (up to four study units).\* You'll enjoy the same great experiences as our exchange students while completing your studies.

### **ACADEMIC YEAR**

The Academic year at UC is based on two main semesters. Semester 1 usually runs from February to May and Semester 2 usually runs from August to November. For latest dates visit the website

### **CHOOSING STUDY UNITS**

At UC, we have a wide selection of study units available to Exchange and Study Abroad students. Most students complete either first year or second year units, however so long as you meet the prerequisite requirements, you can complete third year units too. Most units are worth 3 credit points, however some units are 6 credit points which means you will be doing the work of two study units. You will choose three to four units for a single semester.

### **CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY**

- Have successfully completed at least one year of full-time study at your home university
- ✓ Have at least an average grade point average of 4.5 on a 7-point scale.
- Enrol for full-time study at UC, i.e., 12 credit points, or four units/subjects, per semester.
- Meet all UC entry requirements, including English language requirements outlined below.

### SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Academic certificates and transcripts (both in original and English language)
- English proficiency results (if applicable)
- Copy of passport (photo page)

### **EXPLORE OUR UNITS**

Select 12 credit points, or four units, per semester. Ensure units are offered at our Bruce campus in the correct semester of study.

### **EXCHANGE STUDENTS**

After choosing to embark on the adventure of a lifetime and make the University of Canberra your new temporary home, it's essential to have your home university nominate you using the nomination form provided to all partner universities.

### STUDY ABROAD STUDENTS

Study Abroad students can apply directly to UC as an international student using the course code 315AG for a single semester and NAU003 for full-year the Study Abroad program.

### **ACCEPT YOUR OFFER**

If eligible, you will be emailed your offer details, including an invitation to accept and pay fees for Study Abroad. This document will also include information on your myUC portal login and visa and other necessary steps you will have to complete before coming to UC.

### **GET A STUDENT VISA**

You will then be issued with a Confirmation of Enrolment (COE), which is required when applying for an Australian Student Visa
